2 erasers(cut in half)

2 boxes pencil crayons (long)

2 ring binder file

20 HB pencils (only Croxley or staedler pencils please)

2 packs retractable "wind ups"

3 A4 un-ruled (Blank) 72 page - exercise books

9 A4 Feint and Margin 72 page - exercise books 10 plastic sleeves

1 box of 25 oil pastels

4 <u>large</u> Pritt (43g) or Gloy(40g) (Not liquid glue) (Please buy only Pritt or Gloy brand others don't stick)

2 pencil bags (NOT space case) or 1 UHS pencil bag 1 chair bag (XTT) (can use Grade 1 bag) 2 packs of 10 tissue packets (with 10 packets)

1 sharpener

1 Black Artline 700 marker

1 Black Artline 70 marker

1 30cm ruler

1 pair of scissors

1 highlighter

1 Black White board markers (NOT PERMANENT)

1 colour White board markers (NOT PERMANENT)

1 water colour paint tray set (can use from Grade 1)

art apron / shirt

colouring –in book/ Activity book - large

1 green book bag (For sale at office @ R70) (can use Grade 1 bag)

1 odd sock
